I am very thankful for the NHS for saving lives.



Porpoise Spotting



How to Grow Potatoes at Home

A guide by Abbie (Y3)

I have been doing this for the first time this year. All you need is:

- A packet of seed potatoes
- Some potato grow bags
- Compost



Two months ago I placed the seed potatoes in an egg box for a few days inside the house, until their shoots became 3cm long.

I then filled these potato grow bags with 15cm of compost and kept the potatoes apart.

They have been outside in the sunshine and have been watered everyday since.

As they grow higher, keep adding compost until near the top of the bag.

Woke up this morning, the sun was shining bright, it made me want to scream. Can't go to school, can't play out, thanks a lot Covid-19.


No visits to my family, no days out in the sun, we have to stay at home all day long, Covid-19 you're no fun!
