

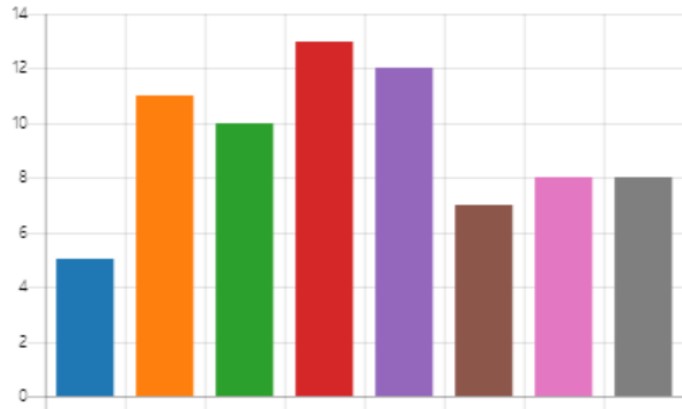
Summary of Responses

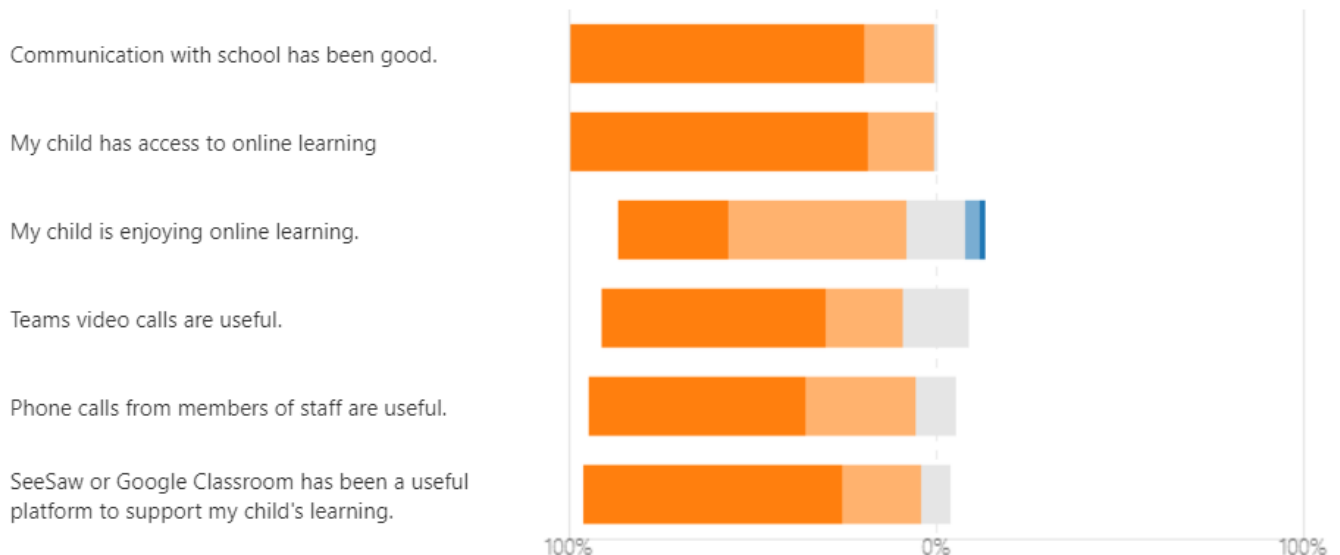


2. How would you rate your child's current wellbeing? (where 1 is lowest and 10 is highest)

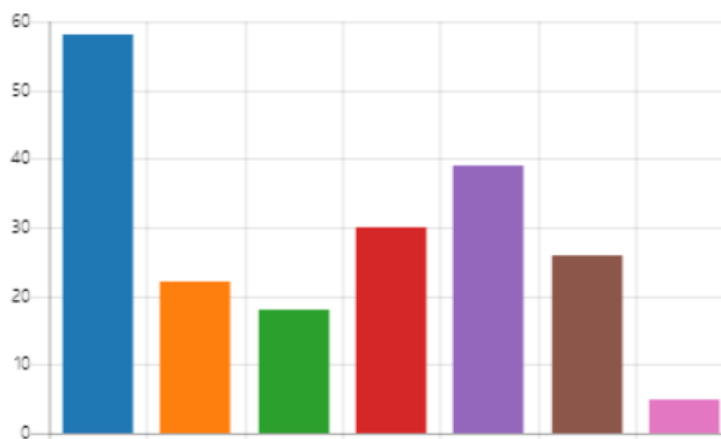
4. The amount of work my child has been provided with is.....
