PURPOSE

The purpose of the 200 Club is to raise funds towards maintenance and development of our estate. The money will be paid into a dedicated 200 Club bank account and used for maintenance and development of the School, and for the provision of matched funding to secure grants from the Welsh Assembly for larger building or refurbishment projects.

RULES

- 1. For a cost of £1 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 200.
- 2. A draw will be made every month, with a 1st and 2nd prize.
- 3. First prize will be £50 and second prize £10. If membership falls, the prize fund will be reduced accordingly.
- 4. The 200 Club is a registered Small Society Lottery (No. 088546) and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of St Joseph's Catholic Primary School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
- 5. Payments must be made by standing order (monthly or annually), or annual cheque or cash payment.
- 6. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 7. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
- 8. The draw shall usually be made by members of the PTA on the last Friday of each month at their Friday morning coffee meeting in the Parish Community Centre.
- 9. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application within one week of the draw.
- 10. The 200 Club will be run by a Club Coordinator, to be appointed by the PTA. In case of any dispute the decision of the PTA Committee is final.
- 11. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 200 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 12. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be directed towards the Club's charitable purposes.
- 13. Club records may be stored on a computer, and will only be used for administration of the Club and communication with members.
- 14. The Club Coordinator is responsible for the administration of the monthly draws, and for accurate maintenance of all financial and membership records of the Club.
- 15. Winners' names and numbers may be published by the PTA to promote the Club; and a full list of winners and winning numbers is available from the Club Coordinator.
- 16. Relevant charges and administrative costs will be met from the retained income.
